Sheep and Meat Goat Weigh in

When: May 6 | 8:00 am—Noon

Where: Fairgrounds

Who: All market and commercial ewe lambs as well as meat goats must be weighed, tagged and have ID forms completed. 4-H Families must complete animal ID in 4honline 2.0 after weigh in.

All sexually intact animals brought to weigh-in must have an official scrapie tag in their ear

State Fair: Any animal potentially being shown at the State Fair must be retinal imaged. This will cost \$5/head.

Tri-County 4-H Camp is a three-day camp for 4th, 5th and 6th grade youth from Boone, Hardin, Marshall, and Story Counties. Camp Counselors will plan theme-based activities, provide leadership for these activities, ensure campers are safe and are having a great camping experience. Counselors will enhance leadership, communication, and volunteer skills. Counselors must be at least 16 years old by August 8. Counselors are required to participate in training on August 8 beginning at 9:00 am at the Y Camp northwest of Boone.

Youth for the Quality Care of Animals Required Training

Are you planning to exhibit an animal at the Boone County Fair or Iowa State Fair this summer? Check out the list below of the species that are required to complete the YQCA Training in order to exhibit.

Required Certification: All 4-H beef, sheep, swine, dairy, goats, rabbits, poultry exhibitors must be Youth for the Quality Care of Animals certified by July 1st.

There are two ways to complete the required training:

- ONLINE The YQCA online training is \$12/person per year and can be completed online at https://yqcaprogram.org/ Training is based on the exhibitors age, not their grade, with a test at the end that must be passed. After completing training, a certificate of completion will be available for download. These certificates must be emailed, mailed or dropped off to Natalie Hedlund, 4-H Coordinator: natm@iastate.edu or 1327 SE Marshall St, Boone 50036.
- 2. **FACE TO FACE** There are two face to face YQCA trainings scheduled. March 13th from 3:00 4:30 pm or 6:00 7:30 pm at the Community Building at the Boone County Fairgrounds. Registration is required to attend. Register online https://yqcaprogram.org/ and pay the \$3 online before the training.

I highly recommend looking over the instructions before starting to avoid the wrong name listed on the certificate.

Dog Obedience, Rally & Agility classes are starting soon!

There will be a Dog Class Orientation meeting on Sunday, March 26th from 6:30 -7:30 pm at the Erb Center at the Boone County Fairgrounds. This meeting is very important for ALL members planning to exhibit dog at the county fair. At Orientation, we will be going over the plan for the classes, rules, supplies needed and much more.

Do NOT bring your dog to the March 26th meeting. **Bring to the orientation meeting proof of rabies vaccination.

Dog classes will be held on Sundays starting April 2nd. Classes will be at the Boone County Fairgrounds from 6:30 - 8:30 pm each Sunday up until Fair. This year the Sunday Dog Classes will include Obedience, Rally, Showmanship and Agility. Exhibitor and dog teams must attend 50% of classes held in order to show at the county fair. Cancelled classes don't count toward the 50%.

Don't forget to ID your dog in 4honline by May 15th. The ID does include a photo of your current rabies certificate. I will be available at the March 26th meeting to assist with IDing your dog for anyone who would like help.

Animal Science Roundup

June 27-29, 2023

Animal Science Roundup is a three-day immersive program for youth grades 8-12 that have an interest in one of the following areas: beef cattle, dairy cattle, dogs, horse, poultry, sheep, or swine. Youth spend time on the lowa State University research and teaching farms working with animals learning about health, nutrition, behavior, genetics, and reproduction. Each project is limited to the first 20 youth that sign up but if you do not get your first choice you can be considered for another project. Evening activities are the same as the conference delegates.

Registration is open in 4-Honline starting on March 15th.

The event will begin with a large group program on antibiotics and end with an escape room activity based on animal welfare.

If you've completed 8th grade, you're eligible to attend. You don't even have to be in 4-H to attend this conference!



 - o Beginners will also enjoy learning the different parts of a rocket, observing the basics of launch and forces (gravity, thrust, lift, drag), and practicing model rocket safety
- 2nd year members will build a Big Bertha[™] rocket
- 3rd year members will build a Bull Pup 12D™ rocket
- 4th year members will build a Centuri rocket
