Awards Selection

The Records and Recognition Taskforce members enjoyed reviewing **44 record books**, 12 Spirit Award nominations, 6 ICARE Award nominations and 7 scholarship applications in an effort to select this year's award recipients. They also reviewed Participation Summaries from 60 4-H'ers to review for **121 project awards**!

Throughout this process, the taskforce created a list of comments to share with 4-H'ers of how they could improve their record keeping process:

Be sure to put everything you've done on your **Yearly Participation Summary** as this is the first thing looked at during awards selection. Please remember to use the Boone County Yearly Participation Summary since it is easier to read and understand. Do NOT use the Yearly Summary from Iowa 4-H.

Your projects goals should continue to progress each year. Make sure you are setting goals that allow you to grow in that project area and that your goals include a timeline. The same goal each year doesn't show growth.

Remember that your goal needs to be something that you can control. A goal to get a purple ribbon is not something that you can control. You can't control what the judge thinks therefore that is not a good goal.


