DEADLINES...

- May 15th **Livestock ID's** Due in <https://ia.4honline.com/>
Bottle Bucket, Breeding Beef, Dairy Cattle, Dog, Goats, Horse, Pets, Breeding Sheep, Swine (Market Beef, Market Sheep/Goats & Swine ID's are on file at the Extension Office from weigh in). No ID's for Poultry and Rabbit. Clover Kids need to ID their animals by May 15th also.
- June 15th County **Fair Entry** Deadline
 - Communication, Fashion Revue, Crop and All Animal entries, except swine are due in <https://bremer.fairentry.com/>
 - Fees are also due to the Extension Office on or postmarked by June 15th
 - **NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED....NO EXCEPTIONS**
 - FSQA Trained or Tested (Required for Beef, Bottle Bucket, Dairy, Goat, Sheep, Swine, Rabbit, Poultry). Not required of Clover Kids. This is recorded in your 4HOnline account.
 - Clover Kids entry in FairEntry.com for above events also
- July 1st All State Fair entries due (online)
- TBA Crop Judging
- July 15th All Static (non-livestock), Horticulture & Swine entries due online on <https://bremer.fairentry.com/>
 - Fees do not get paid until day of judging (only pay for what you bring)
 - Clover Kids enter Statics (non-livestock)
 - Swine Exhibitors – Premise ID number, COOL form, Fees are also due to the Extension Office on or postmarked by July 15th

- July 24-July30th County Fair
- July 24th Static (non-livestock) Judging
 - Please come at your club assigned times
 - Go to entry table to enter your exhibit, get your barcode card and pay entry fee
 - Get your exhibit judged
 - Go to exit table to check out and get your ribbons
- July 31st Release of Exhibits and Animals between 7 & 9 am. Anything removed before will forfeit all premiums. Fair Clean Up
- August 1-5th Any Static (Non-Livestock) Projects selected for Iowa State Fair are due to the Extension Office. Food & Nutrition can be brought in on Aug 9th between 8 and 9 am.

Copyright Information: For projects using someone else's work and it has been copyrighted. The exhibitor needs to obtain permission from the person or company, in order to use for example a logo, cartoon, etc. For recipes or ideas off of pinterest, the exhibitor needs to site the original source and where they located the recipe or idea.
