Entry fee is \$4.00 per class or \$20.00 per horse per rider all day to be paid on show date. Entries must be turned in at least two classes prior to the class to be entered. Halter class will be limited to current 4-H/FFA kids. Class 13 is a double entry and double award class and open entries are eligible to show in this class. A horse/pony can only be shown in one pleasure class (classes 21-26). Prizes will be awarded to the top five finishers in each class. Each out of county 4-H/FFA member must have a copy of their 4-H/FFA horse ID form and sign a release of liability waiver. Dress is to be blue western style jeans, plain white shirt with a 4-H/FFA emblem or armband, hat, boots or hard soled shoes. Open class participants will be required to wear a long sleeve shirt, blue jeans and boots. **Approved riding helmets are required for all participants during all riding classes.** The judge's decision is final.
