

# Iowa State University Aquatic Research Facility (ISU-ARF)

## **Mission Statement:**

The mission of the Iowa State University Aquatic Research Facility (ISU-ARF) is to provide a premier regional facility that promotes the advancement of aquatic research through infrastructure and resources provided through the Agriculture Experiment Station.

## **Vision Statement:**

With leadership by the Natural Resource Ecology and Management Department, the coordinated use of the ISU-ARF would allow personnel to achieve excellence in aquatic research.

## **Operational Philosophy:**

Given the resources provided by the NREM Department and the College of Agriculture, this facility serves a primary role in NREM aquatic research. Researchers in similar fields work in collaboration with oversight by the ISU-ARF committee.

## **Committee:**

The ISU-ARF committee, which consists of three faculty members, two with NREM and one outside faculty member (EEOB), the facility manager, and the farm supervisor, works to facilitate the management of those facilities. The facility manager and farm manager will act as ex officio members of this committee.
