Directions : To Nodaway Valley Park: From Clarinda: Take Highway 2 East out of Clarinda to the intersection of Highway 2 and Highway 71. Turn North on highway 71 for 1.5 miles until you see a brown sign indicating Nodaway Valley Park on the East side of the Road.

From Highway 71/Highway 34 Intersection: Drive south on Highway 71 for 17.5 miles until you see a brown sign indicating Nodaway Valley Park on the East side of the road.
