Directions: From the corner of Hwy 3 and State Hwy 977 (the bypass around Cherokee Iowa) head east on Hwy 3 approximately 1.5 miles to County Hwy M10 (also labeled on some maps as County Hwy C). Head north on M10 for 5 miles and take a right (east) at the T intersection (480th street). Go ½ mile on 480th and turn back to the North on Smith Rd. In 1 mile, Smith Rd will turn to the east and the tree farm is directly north of the curve. There will be field day signs posted at the entrance to the tree farm on Smith Rd.
