Directions

Meet at Stan and Tonny Tate's at 13802 County Line Rd, Ainsworth, Iowa 52201

Directions from the west; Take **highway 218** (Avenue of the Saints) to **County Rd G-52** (the Old White Way) which is 3 miles south of Ainsworth, Iowa. Go East on **G-52** for 3 miles, then turn to the north (left turn) on **County Line Rd** and drive 1.3 miles. You will see the driveway on the right hand side, winding back into the woods. It is marked with a street sign that says " Tate's Creek Road". Drive to the top of the drive for parking.
