

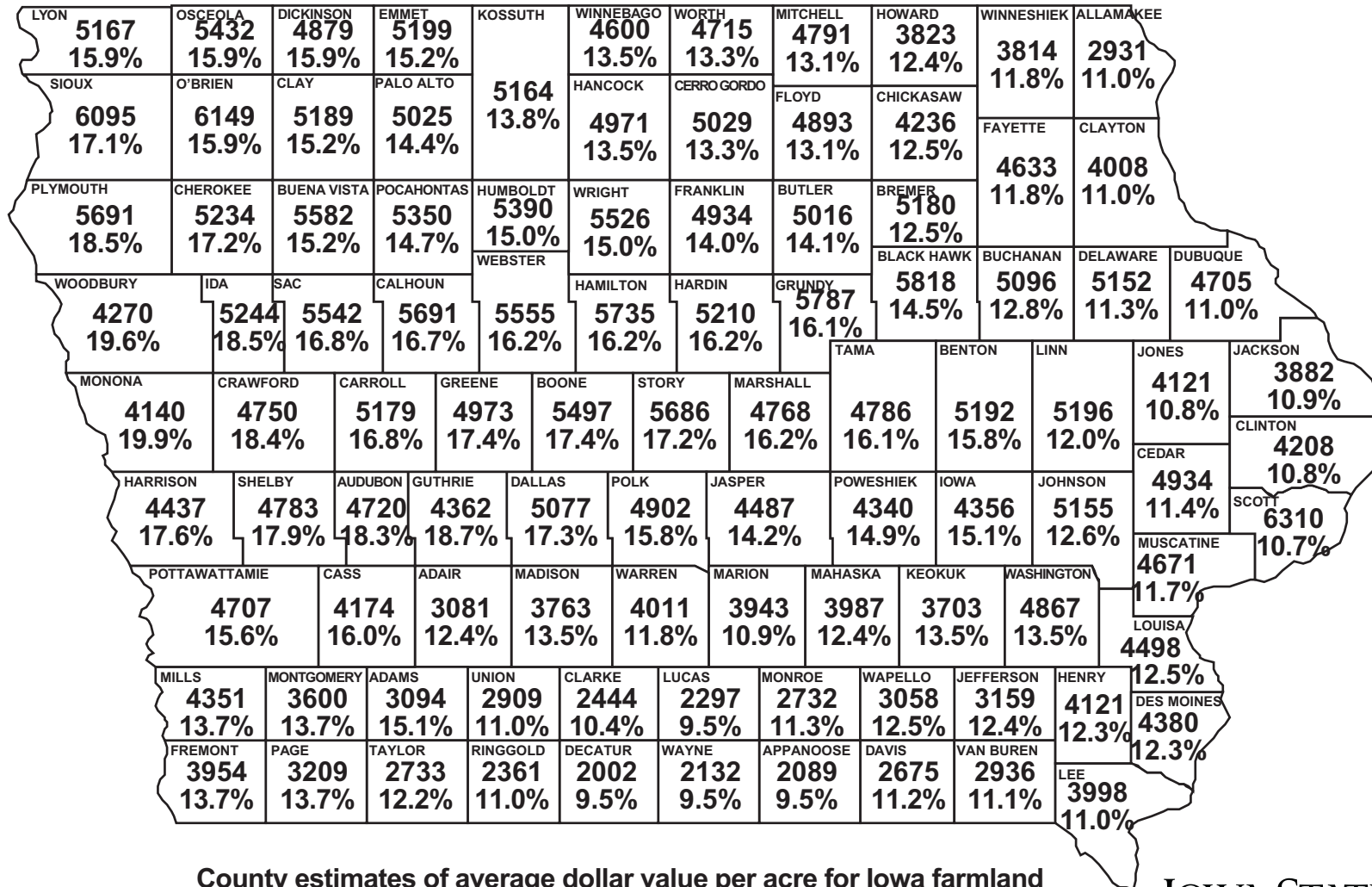

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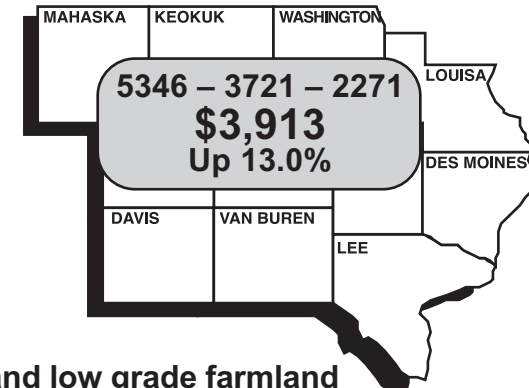
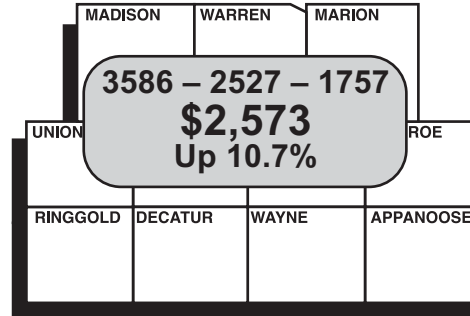
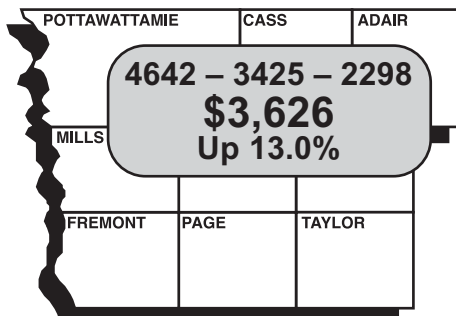
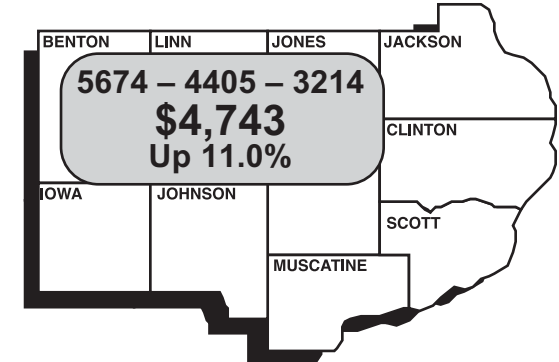
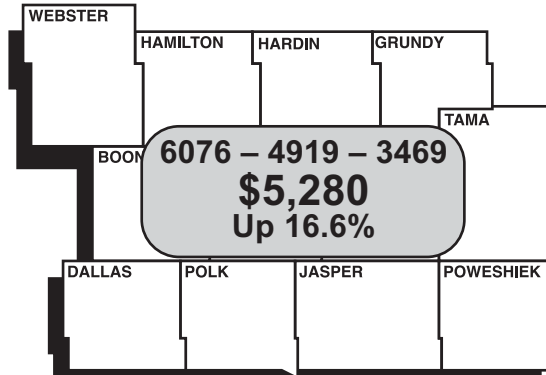
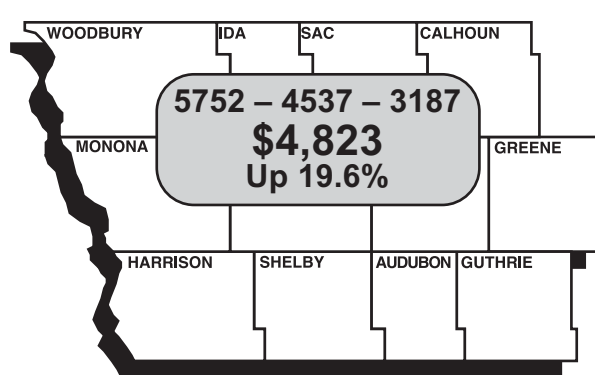
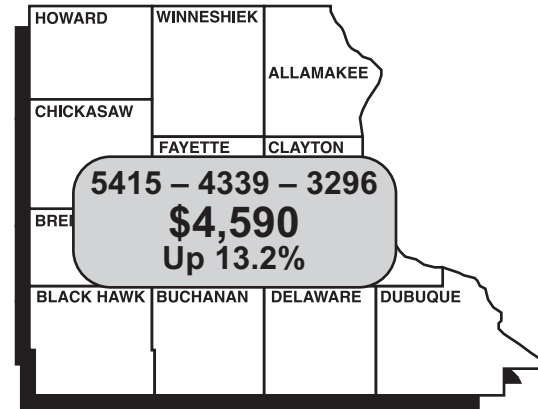
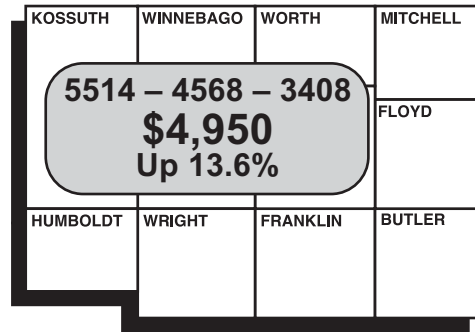
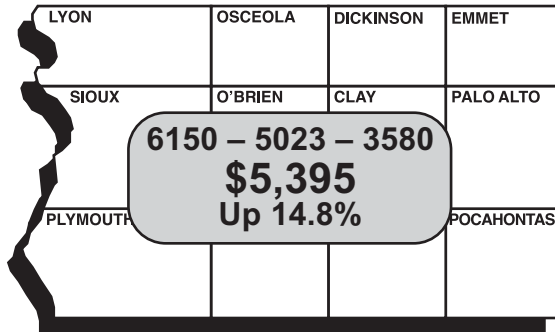
Percentage Change in Iowa Land Values 2007 to 2008

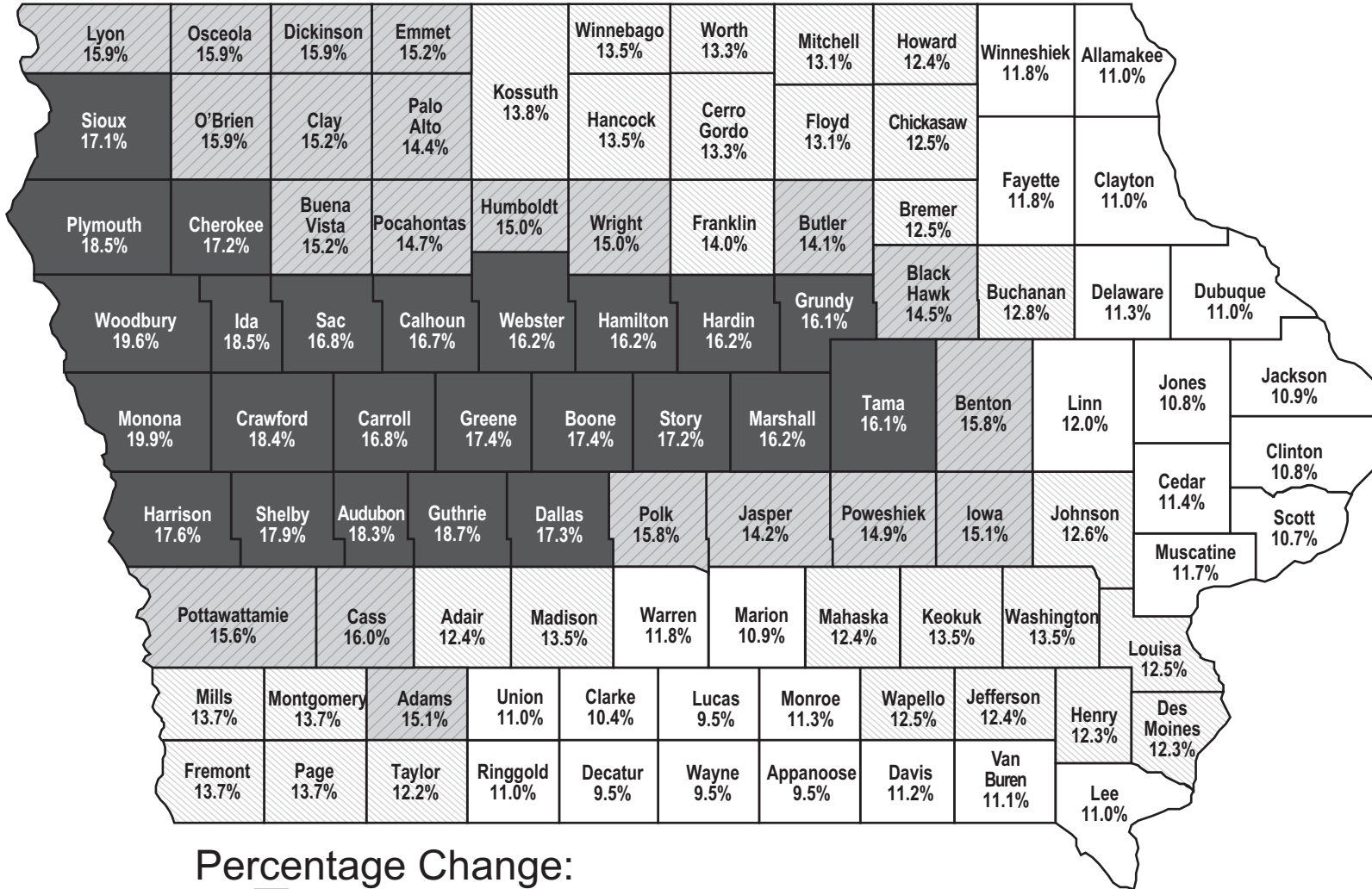
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2008 Iowa Land Values by Crop Reporting District

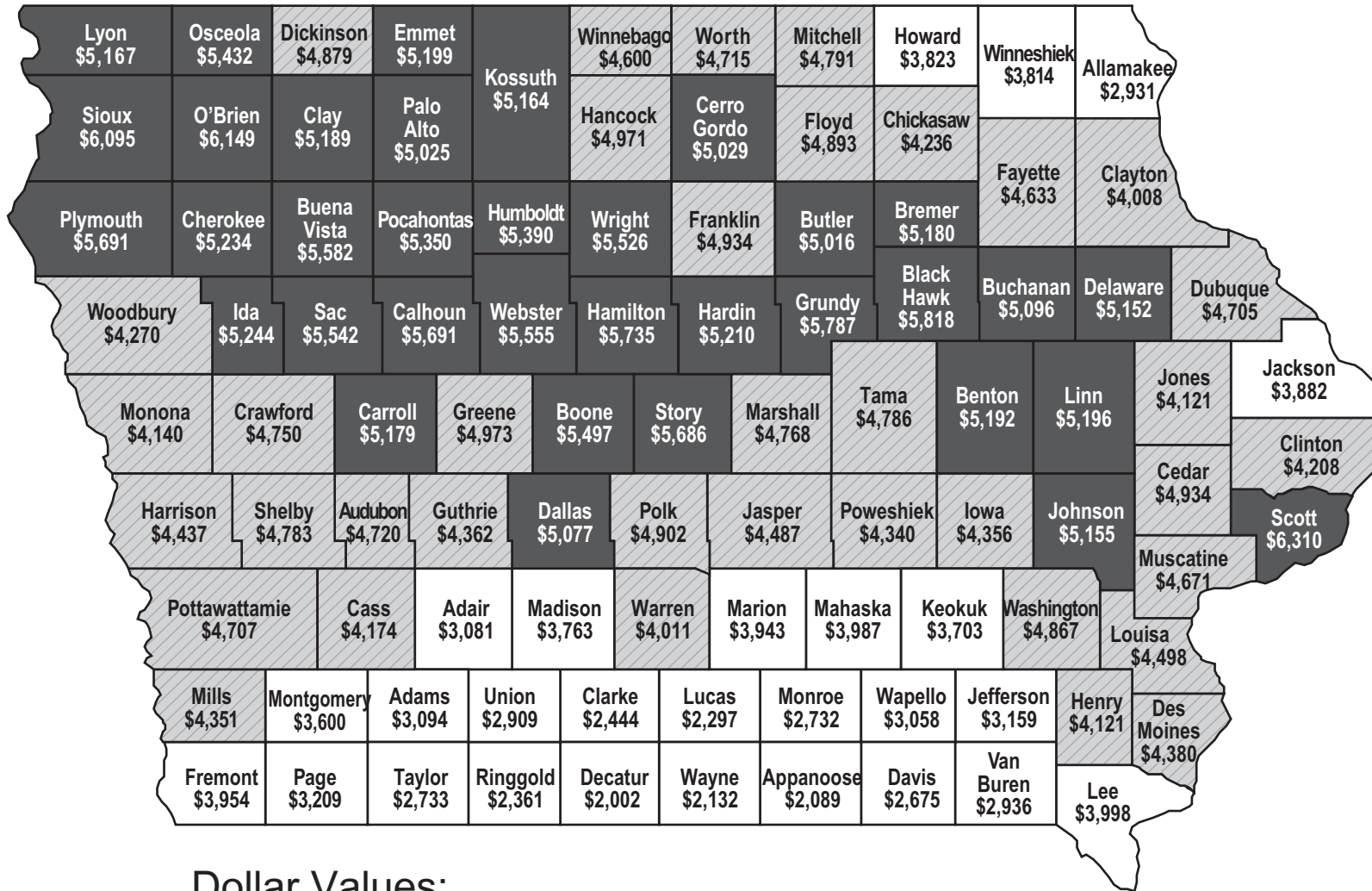
Percentage Change in Iowa Land Values 2007 to 2008
