- $4-H$ Members may receive once as a Junior ( $4^{\text {th }}-6^{\text {th }}$ grade), Intermediate ( $7^{\text {th }}-9^{\text {th }}$ grade) and Senior ( $10^{\text {th }}-12^{\text {th }}$ grade).


## Merit ( 6 Awards)

Club leaders' or adults' recognition of 4-H'ers who have shown outstanding personal growth through citizenship, community and club leadership and unselfish service to others. Recommendation should contain documentation of the 4-H'ers personal growth in unselfish service to others.

- 4-H Members may receive once as a Junior ( $4^{\text {th }}-6^{\text {th }}$ grade), Intermediate ( $7^{\text {th }}-9^{\text {th }}$ grade) and Senior ( $10^{\text {th }}-12^{\text {th }}$ grade).


## Outstanding 4-H'er Award (3 Awards)

Recognition of a 4-H member for outstanding leadership to their local club, county and possibly out-of-county activities through project areas. The $4-\mathrm{H}$ member should be involved in activities other than $4-\mathrm{H}$, such as school, church, and community. The $4-H$ member must be a Senior Level Member ( $10^{\text {th }}, 11^{\text {th }}$ or $12^{\text {th }}$ grader).

- Leaders may nominate up to three individuals from their club.
- Three Outstanding 4-H'er Award recipients will be chosen in the county.
- 4-H members may receive the award only once during their 4-H career.
