WHO, WHAT, WHEN, WHERE, AND WHY

<u>Superintendents:</u> There will be a pre-fair meeting to set up stall assignments at the Extension Office on July 7th at 7 PM. Note that this is 2 weeks before the fair.

Volunteers: If you missed the Annual Volunteer Training back in October, please complete your PY21 Annual Training in 4-H Online. Those who still need to complete the training were emailed by Sara. Training must be completed by **July 1, 2022**.

4-H Members: Mahaska County has a **75% attendance policy** in place for 4-H members of community and special-interest clubs. Members attending at least 75% of their clubs' meetings, activities, and/or pre-approved 4-H experiences will have eligibility to exhibit at the county fair. Clubs can set their own parameters within the 75% policy. We recommend if members are part of an *additional* special-interest club, like Honor Council, that their attendance combined for both will count toward the 75%.

LET'S GET READY FOR FAIR TIME YA'LL

As we all know, making sure our fairgrounds are clean and ready for fair is a community effort. So here are some clean up and decorating dates that you'll want to remember to get our fair ready because **THERE'S NO TIME LIKE FAIR TIME!**

Pre-Fair Barn Clean-Up:

Barn clean up and decorating will take place from **5 PM-7 PM** at the fairgrounds on **July 14th**

Exhibit Hall & 4-H Building Clean-Up and Set-Up:

Exhibit Hall clean up and set up will take place from **3 PM-5 PM** at the Exhibit Hall and 4-H Building at the fairgrounds on **July 9th**

Static Exhibit Help:

Need help getting your static exhibits ready for fair? Stop by the Extension Office to get the forms and tags you need. Call the office a head of time so that we can get everything ready for you.

YQCA:

YQCA is required for 4-H & FFA members exhibiting Poultry, Rabbits, Sheep, Beef, Dairy, Swine, Meat Goat, & Myotonic Goat. It is <u>not</u> required for Bucket/Bottle, Llama/Alpaca, or Horse project exhibitors. YQCA is an online training that can be completed at home or at the Extension office (by appointment). Cost to take the online training is \$12.00 each year. Those who complete a financial aid application at the Extension office will automatically receive a coupon code to use. YQCA must be completed by <u>JULY 1</u> for members to be eligible to exhibit livestock at the county and/or state fair. You will complete the training for the age that you currently are. Once completed, email a copy to mahaska4h@iastate.edu. If you need help with recovery of certification from the old platform please contact Amy Alderson at amy@registrationmax.com.

FairEntry:

FairEntry is now open! Animals MUST BE IDENTIFIED IN 4-H ONLINE or on the FFA ID GOOGLE FORMS by May 15 for any animals to be eligible to be exhibited at the fair. Your YQCA certification number is required when registering Livestock Entry for the Southern Iowa Fair will close on July 1, 2022. Static Entry will close on July 11, 2022.

Beef Carcass:

Packets must be turned in to the Extension Office by **July 1st** to be eligible for purple or blue ribbons. Interviews will be held at the **Extension Office on July 14th from 3 PM-7 PM.**
