All animals must be identified online by **May 15th**, **2022!** Please make sure you enter all identification information when entering the information online. **Reminder**, **May 15th is on a Sunday**, **so please keep that in mind when entering information**.

\*Bulk bedding will no longer be supplied. Exhibitors will need to bring their own or purchase bedding at the fair. There will not be a bedding fee when entry forms are turned in. \*

#### **Swine Tagging**

Tags will be here soon! Watch for an update of when they arrive!

- Exhibitors need to contact the Extension Office to request tags and taggers. You can email xpoweshiek@iastate.edu or call 641-623-5188 to reserve the tags/taggers.
- State Fair Swine ID packets need to be back to the Extension Office by noon on May 10th. This
  will give us time to get packets mailed to the State Office.
- Families will need to fill the form out and input information into 4-H online by May 15th. All swine must be ear notched. Ear notches must be included in 4honline.

- FFA Members need to supply the fair office and extension office a copy of identification information.

- Breeding Doe
   — Do not need to be
   weighed but will need to be identified in
   4honline with a Scrapie Tag (including
   your flock number and animal identifier
   and/or tattoo).

   — Retinal Scan,
   provide animal Scrapie Tag with
   Flock ID and Animal ID After Weighin.

#### YQCA UPDATE

All 4-H livestock exhibits are required to be certified for county/state fair exhibition for the following species: beef, dairy cattle/goat, meat goat, rabbit, poultry, sheep & swine by July 1st.

- All exhibitors must create a new account on <u>www.yqcaprogram.org</u> website. They must upload their current YQCA Certificate to this website. This includes this year's certificates.
- To show livestock at the county fair, YQCA training must be done by July 1st, 2022.

#### How to register for online training:

- 1. Visit <a href="https://www.yqcaprogram.org">www.yqcaprogram.org</a>. Create an account & select the course for the 4-H member based on their age as of 1/1/22.
- 2. Choose the training you wish to complete (Purchase and complete the training.)
- 3. ALL YQCA TRAININGS COMPLETED IN-PERSON OR ONLINE MUST PROVIDE THE EXTENSION OFFICE WITH A COPY OF CERTIFICATE.

#### **Montezuma Library Programs**

We will visit the Montezuma Public Library twice a month (Feb-May) for story time and STEM activities!

- \*Afterschool on the second Tuesday of every month, we will doing STEM activities for grades 3-6.
- \*The last Tuesday of each month, we will be assisting with Storytime!







#### **Nature Club**

For the month of April, youth will be learning all about first aid when outdoors. Youth will even go home with a very basic first aid kit..

For the month of March, youth got to meet a box turtle, Petunia the snapping turtle, and a painted turtle. Youth learned all about turtles and the different types of lowa turtles. Members also got to work and practice with dichotomous keys.











#### **Clover Kid After-School Program**

Program theme is The Secret Life of Squirrels – Participants will engage in a mathematics activity that addresses the concept of spatial relationships by using maps and positional words. They will set up, navigate, and draw a map of an obstacle course. Lastly, participants will then learn about tree development and what roll a squirrel plays in planting those trees.


