

YQCA

All 4-H livestock exhibitors are required to be YQCA certified for the county/state fair exhibition for the following species: beef, dairy cattle/goat, meat goat, poultry, rabbit, sheep & swine.

How to register for online:

- 1. Visit https://yqca.learngrow.io/Account/Login
- 2. Login in with your 4-H Online username and password.



- 3. Select the course for the 4-H member based on their age as of 1/1/20.
- 4. Choose the Web-based training.
- 5. Complete registration by purchasing the course—\$12/member for Web-based training.

Healthy Living Challenge

Brought to you by County Youth Council:

Continue working on eating healthy and exercising, but here is a new challenge for you to try! It is important to focus on gratitude and being thankful for everything that we have, which is part of practicing mindfulness. With COVID and everything going on right now, it's important to take time for yourself and to prioritize your mental health!

Create your own Mindfulness Journal! Materials:

- Paper
- Pens, markers, or pencils

With your pieces of paper, fold them in half hamburger style. You can use colorful paper for the cover page if you want. Staple the pages so they stay together or take a piece of string and put two holes and tie them off. Write "4-H Mindfulness Journal" and add whatever drawings you want on the front. After-School Food Recipe!

Frozen Pudding Sandwiches:

Ingredients: 2 cups nonfat milk, 1 package (1-1.5 ounces) fat free, sugar free pudding mix, 1 cup creamy peanut butter, 50 graham cracker squares (25 full sheets broken in half

Instructions:

- 1. stir milk, pudding mix and peanut butter together with wisk or fork. Stir until smooth and think.
- 2. Use tablespoon to spoon mixture onto 25 graham cracker squares. Top with the other 25 squares.
- 3. Place on baking sheet and put in freezer for about 3 hours. Put sandwiches in freezer bag or airtight container and store in freezer.
