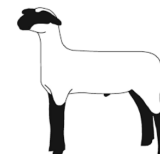
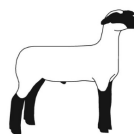

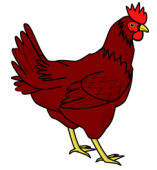


Fair Information

Poultry Exhibitors

Poultry families, the ban has been lifted. We WILL be having a LIVE show!

- But first, all poultry must have a negative Pullorum-Typhoid test within 90 days of showing.
- PT testing will take place on July 7th, 2022 from 1-4pm at the Grinnell Vet Clinic.
- Breeder certificates do not qualify. The test must be performed by an authorized tester.
- Poultry details can be found starting on page 105 of the Fairbook.
