4-H Spotlight!

Congratulations to the Poweshiek Prowlers (Trenten, Zane, Ivy & Cora) on their success at the first ever Iowa 4-H State WHEP Competition! Thank you to their amazing coach Amy Andrews for all her work!

Trenten placed 3rd overall individually and Poweshiek Prowlers placed 1st in the competition!

They as a team worked together to write a 3 page plan that described how they would manage a specific tract of land to meet the need of three target species - northern harrier, red fox, and grasshopper sparrows. Judges complimented them on their ability to write clearly and balance the trade-offs between the different habitats the three species required.

They were also graded on an individual test where they identified animal sounds, pelts, and answered questions about 16 native prairie wildlife species.

Animal Information

YQCA

All 4-H livestock exhibitors are required to have YQCA certified for county and State Fair for the following: Beef, Dairy Cattle/Dairy Goats, Meat Goats, Poultry, Rabbit, Sheep & Swine.

- ⇒ Due July 1st for all youth!
- ⇒ The cost is \$12 per test online. Test out options for first year intermediates and seniors.
- ⇒ Financial assistance is available, contact the Extension Office if needed.
- ⇒ We have one more in-person session on June 19th from 9am-10:30am. Cost is \$3 for in person.

Pullorum testing on poultry will be done on **Thursday, July 1st from 1:30-3:30pm at the Grinnell Vet Clinic**. All poultry must have had a negative Pullorum Typhoid test within 90 days of showing. The test must be performed by an authorized tester.

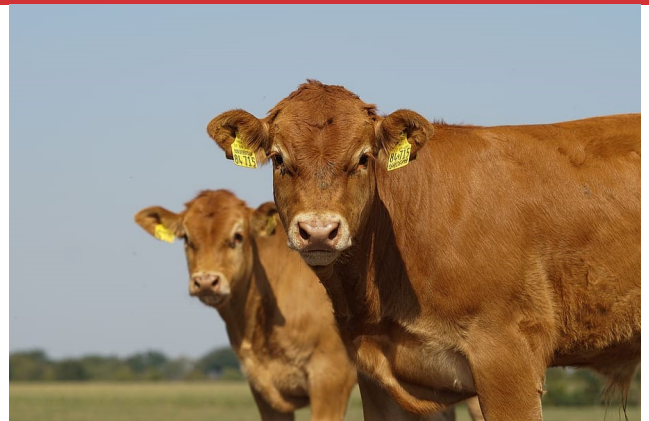
