Youth selected for Roundup MUST register in 4-H Online for the Animal Science Roundup event, NOT State 4-H Conference. Youth not selected for Roundup CAN attend 4-H Conference and can then register for that event in 4-H Online. When: May 7th, 2022 from 8am-11 Where: Poweshiek County Fairgrounds

- *If you are unable to attend on this date, you must let the extension office know as soon as possible.*
- Families will be responsible for entering data into 4-H online by May 15th. Help sheets will be given at weigh in. Our office will than verify information. All Market and Breeding need to be entered by May 15th.
- FFA Members need to supply the fair office and extension office a copy of identification information.

Poweshiek County Fair Identification/Weigh-in Guidelines

Sheep:

- Market

 Weigh-in and Tag
- Commercial Ewes
 — Weigh-in and Tag, Birthdates, Scrapie tag with Flock ID and Animal ID***
- Purebred Breeding Ewes— Do not need to be weighed in, but will need to be entered into 4honline (birthdate, breed, and scrapie tag with Flock ID and Animal ID).

Meat Goats:

- Market Wether

 Weigh-in and Tag
- Breeding Doe
 — Do not need to be
 weighed but will need to be
 identified in 4honline with a
 Scrapie Tag (including your flock
 number and animal identifier and/
 or tattoo)

Iowa State Fair Identification/Weigh-in Guidelines

 Scan and provide animal Scrapie
 Tag with Flock ID and Animal ID

 — Retinal Scan,
 provide animal Scrapie Tag with
 Flock ID and Animal ID After Weighin.

 — Weigh-in, Tag, and Retinal Scan
- Breeding Doe
 — Retinal Scan at
 Weigh-in and provide animal
 birthdate, Scrapie Tag and/or Tattoo
 with Flock ID and Animal ID

Montezuma Library Programs

Animal ID

All animals must be identified online by **May 15th**, **2022!** Please make sure you enter all identification information when entering the information online.

*Bulk bedding will no longer be supplied. Exhibitors will need to bring their own or purchase bedding at the fair.

There will not be a bedding fee when entry forms are turned in.

YQCA

To show livestock at the county fair, YQCA training must be done by July 1st, 2022.

How to register for online:

- 1. Visit https://yqca.learngrow.io/Account/Login
- 2. Login in with your 4-H Online account & select the course for the 4-H member based on their age as of 1/1/21
- 3. Choose the training you wish to attend or complete and complete registration by purchasing the correct course.

Davis Elementary After School 4-H Adventures

This hands on learning program will be held at Davis Elementary from 3 to 4:30 pm on March 24th and April 21st.

The month of March, members will be using their engineering skills to build a boat to make it float across water!

In February youth, youth engineered a ramp & pathway to get a marble to travel the path. Youth then were able to create their own maze to take home.



Nature Club

For the month of March, youth will be learning all about different animal mouths and jaws. Youth will learn why each animal has the type of mouth/jaw they have.

For the month of February, animals tracks left in the snow can tell us what animal they may be, what they're doing, and where they're headed. Youth will also be learned about common lowa animal tracks










Clover Kid After-School Program

Program theme is Lots of Layers - A collage is an artistic composition of materials and objects pasted over a surface. Collages can be found everywhere, including our food! Clover Kids will learn all about collages by creating a layered pizza out of paper.

In February, we played some teambuilding games. Rainbow Fish and his friends are planning to build an underwater castle to play in. So, participants became architects and learned how stained-glass windows were made. They then engaged in a mathematics activity by designing their own stained-glass window for the Rainbow Fish castle. Lastly, the participants encouraged experiment and play around with light-pads.


