Organizing your Book

Please Organize your record book to be in this correct order:

Cover Page

This page goes in the outside of the pocket of your book. Should have your name and club listed.

Awards Application

This is required for everyone applying for awards. This tells us what awards you would like to be considered for! Please check to have this all the way filled out! Place the completed application in the front inside pocket of your record book!

Title Page

This is the first page of your book. Show have your name, age, grade completed, club & Photo. Make this all about you! * Reminder that this is the grade completed this past year.

4-H Yearly Summary:

This sheet should come next in your book! This form is a way for you to showcase all you have done this year in 4-H! It is more than what you did at fair, it can be attending a workshop, community service etc.

Project Sheets

These are for Event day, Indoor Judging and Livestock or projects not brought to fair! Reminder to only fill out one per project area. Example..... Brought the following: 2 pictures, 3 swine, 2 visual arts. You would fill out 1 form for your pictures, 1 form for your swine and 1 form for your visual arts. You DONOT fill out a form per project only per project area! If confused, please ask!

Support Material

Support Material can be placed behind the project sheets. This can be anything from pictures, newspaper clippings etc.

Simply check what areas you would like to be considered for!

General Awards

Check the awards you would like to be considered for on the application. Than you will attend an interview!

Special Awards

Check the awards you would like to be considered for on the application. You can either write an essay or attend an interview. Each awards has a topic for your essay.

Outstanding Member:

You will answer the questions on the application form, to be considered for outstanding member!

Note: We have added awards for all levels! Make sure to read through the application to see what all you would like to apply for!

This year everyone will have an awards application to fill out.

 Fill out the awards application and attend an interview! Add support material based on the awards you wish to apply for! i.e.- pictures, newspaper & clippings


