What is Windows Vista?

- Next release of Microsoft Windows
- Successor to Windows XP
 - Released October, 2001
- First Windows version to go through the Security Development Lifecycle

Do I have to upgrade?

- New computers will soon come preloaded with Windows Vista
- There is no immediate need to upgrade existing computers
- Computers at EIT for repair will soon be reinstalled only with Vista

What's new in Windows Vista?

- Aero user interface
- Instant search
- Internet Explorer 7
- Defender
- User Account Control

Is that all?

- No!
- Many new features “under the hood”
 - Rewritten TCP/IP stack; IPv6
 - Windows Integrity Control to secure services
 - PatchGuard for 64-bit systems
 - Firewall and IPSec improvements
 - User Account Control
