How many people called?

Teen Line received 174 calls for the month of October. This is a decrease of 33 calls from the previous month.

Who called?

The average caller was 19 years old, female (55% female, 20% male), and remained on the line for 5 minutes. Nineteen percent of the calls were made by adults. Seven percent of the callers were using our service for the second time or more.

Topics of discussion:

The greatest number of calls were categorized as relationship concerns (19%). Of these thirty-three calls, 56% revolved around family issues, 18% were concerned about boy and/or girl relationships, and another 26% were relating to peer and friend situations.

The remaining calls were categorized as follows: abuse (7 or 4%), birth control (2 or 1%), educational (10 or 6%), employment (1 or 1%), foster care/aftercare (5 or 3%), hang-ups (37 or 21%), health (8 or 5%), information about hotline (9 or 5%), legal (4 or 2%), lonely or just needed to talk (6 or 3%), other (11 or 6%), prank (15 or 9%), pregnancy (10 or 6%), runaway (2 or 1%), sexuality (4 or 2%), suicide (5 or 3%), wrong number (14 or 8%), and You Are Not Alone (1 or 1%).

What was the outcome of the calls?

Of the 174 calls, 50 (29%) required a listening ear and counseling that the Teen Line staff provided. In addition, 19 callers (11%) had a specific question that staff was able to answer. To supplement the information given by staff, 35 referrals (20%) were made. Staff was unable to help the 53 callers (30%) that hung-up or made a prank call.

To whom were the callers referred?

Of the referrals that were made, 8% were to a family planning center, 19% were to the caller's parents, 4% to another hotline, 6% to school personnel, 8% to law enforcement, 10% to medical services, 2% to runaway services, and 10% who were referred to a counselor other than their school counselor. Five callers (10%) were referred to the Iowa Aftercare Services Network.
