
### Fun Facts!

In Nicaragua you can see more stars than anywhere else in the world. There are a total of 88 constellations in the sky and 86 of them can all be seen in Nicaragua. You can sometimes even see planets and comets! This is because Nicaragua is located between the northern and southern hemisphere. This allows the best views of both hemispheres.

## Connection: Find the Stars! ★

In Nicaragua the stars are always shining with bright constellations. A constellation is a group of stars that are together that create a certain pattern or shape in the sky and can be seen without a telescope. In Greek constellation means "set with stars".

Research constellations that can be seen where you live and what time of the year they can be seen. Find the meanings behind the constellations names and try to spot them in the night sky if it's the right time of year!
