- 4-H in Sweden was started by Jordbrukare-Ungdomens Förbund/ Agriculture-Youth Association in the 1920s. The original name was "Young Cultivators"
- The 4-H motto in Sweden is "Learning by Doing". In Swedish it is "Lärande genom att göra"
- Youth in Sweden can be involved in the following project areas: cultivation and animals, forestry and nature, household and culture, games and play.
- Just like in the United States, 4-H is open to all youth in Sweden. You don't have to have an agriculture background to be involved in 4-H in Sweden.
