

**SOUTHEAST IOWA AGRICULTURAL RESEARCH ASSOCIATION  
ANNUAL MEETING  
MARCH 3, 2005**

The meeting was called to order by President Dave Vandenberg at 10:00 am.

Secretary, Greg Brenneman, presented the minutes of the 2004 annual meeting. Motion by Randy Mather and seconded by Rob Stout to approve the minutes as printed. Motion carried. Current paid membership is 335 members plus 18 members whose dues are delinquent 1 year. There are an additional 348 members whose membership is past due 2 to 6 years.

Greg Brenneman presented Treasurer's Report for Treasurer Vivan Jennings. Following is a summary of the report:

The \$104,917.17 income includes \$68,833.71 that was transferred from the Land Expansion Account into checking.

Motion by Darrell Jordan and seconded by Jim Dane to approve the treasurers report as presented. Motion carried.

Kevin Van Dee reported on 2004 activities at the SERF. Corn and soybean yields were excellent in 2004. One of the new studies conducted in 2004 was a relay planting of soybeans into standing wheat that resulted in 65 bu/A wheat and 36 bu/A soybeans. He noted that several new studies are being started in 2005. These included a phosphorous study, a field pea rotation study, a Stewart's wilt by planting date study, a vertical tillage study, and a soybean cyst nematode variety trial.

Dr. Bob Hartzler discussed 8 steps to good weed control in non-GMO soybeans.

Greg Brenneman talked about what is needed for good spray coverage when spraying fungicides and demonstrated how different types of spray nozzles will result in different levels of coverage and potential spray drift.

Dr. Greg Tylka discussed asian soybean rust, where it has been found in the US and what the potential is for ASR in 2005.

Dr. Jim Fawcett presented the results from several insecticide trials and the performance of different insecticide seed treatments.

Dave Vandenberg announced the board member election results.
