The YQCA deadline of completion is July 1st, once you have completed your YQCA please.

be sure to send a copy of your certificate to the Adair County Extension Office. You can email it to csavage@iastate.edu.

You must have an up-to-date YQCA certificate in-order-to show beef, dairy, goat, sheep, swine, rabbit, and poultry.

Be sure to submit your entries for the Adair County Fair online at www.adair.fairentry.com! If you are in 4-H, you can sign in with your 4hOnline credentials. If you are an FFA member you will need to create an account. This video <https://vimeo.com/209918998> will help guide you through signing up online. Table setting, clothing events and apple pie baking will be hosted at the Gathering Place on July 8th. You must register for these events on FairEntry. Once registration has closed, a schedule will be sent to you with your judging time. If you have any difficulties don't be afraid to reach out the Extension Office, everyone is willing to help! Be sure to enter your fair events and exhibits, including animals and static exhibits by July 1st!

2023 State Fair 4-H Livestock & Horticulture Entry

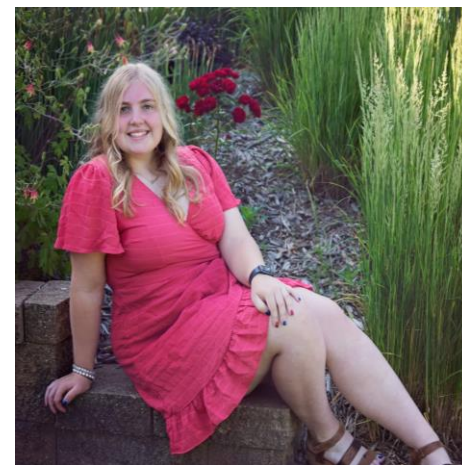
