Code of Conduct Participation Agreement for Competitive Events

Expectations:

It is expected that all persons taking part in any Extension sponsored youth and 4-H activity/trip will conduct themselves in a civil, law-abiding, responsible, cooperative, and courteous manner throughout the entire trip/activity until returning home.

Some Specifics:

- No alcohol or illegal drugs shall be brought from home, bought, or consumed while taking part in this activity.
- Cell phones will be turned off during activities and may be confiscated if used.
- You are expected to use good judgment, and you should realize that there will be consequences for the above infractions and other behavior deemed unreasonable or inappropriate.

Possible Consequences:

- Disqualification and/or separation from group.
- You will be required to write apologies to chaperones and other group members.
- You may be required to give oral apologies to county 4-H committees.
- You may be put on probation and prohibited from participating in further Extension sponsored activities.
