

Youth Council Meeting Minutes

January 6, 2019

The regular monthly meeting of the ADAIR COUNTY 4-H YOUTH COUNCIL was held on Sunday, January 6, 2019 at the 4-H/FFA Building on the Adair County Fairgrounds.

The meeting began at 1:35pm.

Roll Call: Cole took roll call once members arrived. Call to Order: Drake made a motion to start the meeting and Vinh seconded, and Paisley called the meeting to order.

Approve Minutes: Vinh made a motion to approve the minutes and Cadee seconded. All in favor. Motion carried unanimously.

Old Business

Agenda Item #1 Youth Council members placed an order for their t-shirts. Parents and families are welcome to order shirts as well. The cost of shirts is \$17 for sizes SM-XL, \$20 for 2XL, and \$23 for 3XL. Money for t-shirts is due on February 10.

Agenda Item #2 The Youth Council read to 191 preschool students in Adair County in December, and each child received a book to take home. Jill thought this project was worthwhile and enjoyed the craft the preschoolers did, Paisley thought it was a good project, and no one thought any changes were needed.

Agenda Item #3 Storm and Zayden went to the Creston in Walmart on December 9 to buy items for the Adopt-a-Family program. Storm commented on this project and said they bought Legos, clothes, and boots. When asked if this was a worthwhile project to do, Storm replied, "You betcha".

Agenda Item #4 Applications for State Project Awards are due by 11:59pm on February 1. Members applying for State Awards will not have to drive to Ames to do an interview. If members apply for State 4-H Council, Shooting Sports Ambassador, National Conference, or National Congress they will have to do an interview in Ames. Jennifer and Zayden commented about their experience last year. Jennifer said the application process is a challenge, but it is a great way to see how you've grown throughout your 4-H career. Zayden said this year's application process is harder than last year because only 200 words are allowed per questions. All Youth Council members are eligible and highly encouraged to apply for a State Project Award.

Agenda Item #5 At the December meeting, Youth Council briefly discussed hosting another Family Photo Shoot in the spring. That conversation was continued at this meeting, and the Council decided to have their next photo shoot on June 1. Drake will take pictures again and Cadee, Maddie, Jill, and Shelbee will all help. A location has yet to be determined.

Agenda Item #6 Committees briefly met to discuss possible projects they would like to do before County Fair. The poverty/healthy living committee will discuss having a field day, healthy snacks to hand out to youth at fair, and partnering with the backpack program at the schools. The anti-bullying committee is going to record and post a short video on the NVTV news to raise awareness. The scholarship committee would like to have a cool down station at County Fair to raise money for the Kelly Laughery Scholarship. The literacy committee would like to have a writing competition. The 4-H promo committee would like to have water baseball at county fair. The council also decided they would like to visit the nursing homes in Adair County and help them play bingo. These visits will happen in February.

Vinh moved to approve the old business and Cole seconded. All in favor. Motion passed unanimously.

New Business

Agenda Item #1 The Youth Council members all thought the soup luncheon went very well and the event was successful. Jill also wanted to say that Clover Kids went very well.
