

# Youth Council Meeting Minutes

The regular monthly meeting of the ADAIR COUNTY 4-H YOUTH COUNCIL was held on Sunday, May 6 at the Warren Cultural Center in the Green Room.

The meeting began at 2:23 pm.

**Call to Order:** Halee called the meeting to order.

**Approve Minutes:** April minutes were passed out for all members to read through. Madison made a motion to approve the minutes and Skyler seconded. All in favor. Motion passed.

**Old Business.** Sadie still needs to pick up her t-shirt. Youth Council members decided to make a tie blanket for a past member who is struggling with a recurring injury. Halee, Sadie, and Danielle will go to Des Moines and pick out fabric before the June meeting. Members will all help make the blanket after the next meeting and present to the past member. Congratulations to Skyler Rawlings for receiving State 4-H Project Award in Health. Members decided to push back the clothing drive until the winter months so they could collect clothes, hats, and gloves. Clothing items will be donated to a local shop in Greenfield to help families in the community. Youth Council members signed up to help with summer day camps. Each member must sign up for two full days or four half days in order to fulfill their youth mentoring requirements. Members also volunteered to bring animals to two different summer camps to show youth how to properly take care of and show farm animals. The deadline to sign up for State 4-H Conference is June 1. The conference will be held on the Iowa State Campus in Ames on June 26-28. The cost is \$180, but if a thank you note is written to the Youth Action Committee,

they will pay for half of the cost. Members continued their discussion from last meeting about activities to do during Kids' Day at the County Fair. Drake, Madison, and Halee will be on a committee to put together a photo scavenger hunt for youth to participate in. Vinh, Skyler, and Haylee will be organizing water baseball as a way for youth to cool down during the day.
