



Lesson Three: Field Trip Preparations Iowa's Dairy Story TEACHER LESSON PLAN

OBJECTIVE

- Students will have an understanding of what is expected of them as they participate in the tour to the Dairy Education Center.
- Students will share with other students what they saw and learned at the Dairy Center.

Field Trip Preparations:

1. Wrap up unit and briefly review materials that have been covered with the dairy unit.
2. Make final preparations for field trip to Dairy Center
3. Review school policies for school trips
4. Special safety tips for the Dairy Center.
 - You need to be quiet around the animals. You may scare them by sudden noises or quick movements.
 - You will be touring the dairy facilities. Plastic boots are provided for each student and teacher.
 - Never go directly behind an animal.
 - You will walk --not run --at the Dairy Center
 - You need to be good listeners for the total success of the program.
 - Your best behavior is expected on a field trip.
5. Remind students to bring a sack lunch. Milk will be provided for the students and teachers.

Going Further/Optional Activity:

To end the unit, treat the students to "Cheesy Smiles". All students create their own smiles by putting cheese cubes (teeth) inside two wedges of red apples (lips). Work with the school food service director to have cheese cubes and apple wedges prepared.

Yogurt Dip Recipe

1 – 8 oz container of plain yogurt

3 T. of instant vanilla pudding powder

Mix the ingredients together and use as a dip for fresh fruit such as strawberries or apples.
