Record Books for Clover Kids are optional. Project Records are optional.

Clover Kids are...

- ◆ Eligible for Clover Kid Record Keeping Award

JUNIOR & INTERMEDIATE RECORD BOOKS

Junior and Intermediate record books are due to club leaders in September. Club leaders will evaluate your books and submit the 4-H Club Yearly Summary to the Extension Office by **October 1**.

Junior Project Records: At least one Basic 4-H Project Record

Intermediate Project Records: At least one Project Record. We encourage to use the Experienced Project Record. To be considered for Project Awards, 2 previous years' records must accompany the current year's records. Include production records for livestock projects.

Juniors and Intermediates can apply for the Livestock Champion Award. Leaders need to evaluate your book first, then they will be submitted to the Youth Development Committee for review and selection of the Livestock Champion Award. Those applying for this award must include a livestock worksheet with current production records for each species and write a paragraph explaining why you think you should win the County Livestock Champion Award.

Juniors are...

- ◆ Eligible for General Record Keeping Awards (Junior Record Book Completion Award and Livestock Champion Award)

Intermediates are...

- ◆ Eligible for General Record Keeping Awards (Intermediate Record Book Completion Award)
- ◆ Eligible for Project Awards in areas the 4-H'er has at least 3 years experience
- ◆ Eligible for Livestock Champion Award

SENIOR RECORD BOOKS

Senior record books are due to the Extension Office by **October 1** for the Youth Development Committee to review. Interviews or 5 pages of support material are required for Senior Achievement Awards. Those applying for Senior Achievement Awards will be contacted after October 1 for an assigned interview time on **Tuesday, October 11**.

Senior Project Records: Are encouraged to use the Experienced or Advanced Project Records. To be considered for Project Awards, 2 previous years' records must accompany the current year's records. Include production records for livestock projects.

Seniors are...

- ◆ Eligible for General Record Keeping Awards (Senior Record Keeping Award)
- ◆ Eligible for Project Awards in areas the 4-H'ers has at least 3 year experience
- ◆ Eligible for Overall Senior Achievement Awards
