Allamakee County 4-H Clover Kids may participate in the Dog Project at an introductory level. Kindergarten through second graders are invited to participate in the Clover Kids Dog Project classes. Guidelines for participating include:

- *Enrolled as a 4-H Clover Kid in Allamakee County.*
- *Enrolled in the Dog Project.*
- *Complete Dog Project Waiver, have updated vet records including distemper combo and rabies turned in to the Extension Office prior to classes.*
- *\$10 Training Fee.*
- *Please bring treats for your dog, a well fitted collar, and leash.*

Dog Project classes will take place **Tuesday** evenings from **5:30-6:00 PM** at the **Allamakee County Fairgrounds, Beef Barn**. Classes will run Tuesday evenings from May 7-28, 2019. **It is required that a parent/guardian in present in the barn with the 4-H member and dog at all times.** The Dog Project leaders will be working with the youth on basic dog training skills. The Clover Kids will have the opportunity to exhibit their dog at the Allamakee County Fair at the **Clover Kids Pet Show**, scheduled for Thursday, July 18, 2019 at 3:00 PM at the Allamakee County Fair Grounds. *Entry forms for the Pet Show are due to the Extension Office by July 1, 2019.*
