Other project areas may require Principles and Elements of Design depending on the goal of the project. Juniors are required to have one element and one principle of design for these project areas. Intermediates and Seniors are required to have two elements and two principles of design for these project areas.

Why are Write-Ups important? Write-Ups are critical for projects being considered for exhibition at the Iowa State Fair. 4-H projects are not conference judged at the Iowa State Fair, so a member's Write-Up is the only resource a judge has when learning about a member's project. Write-Ups should be complete and easy to read.
