

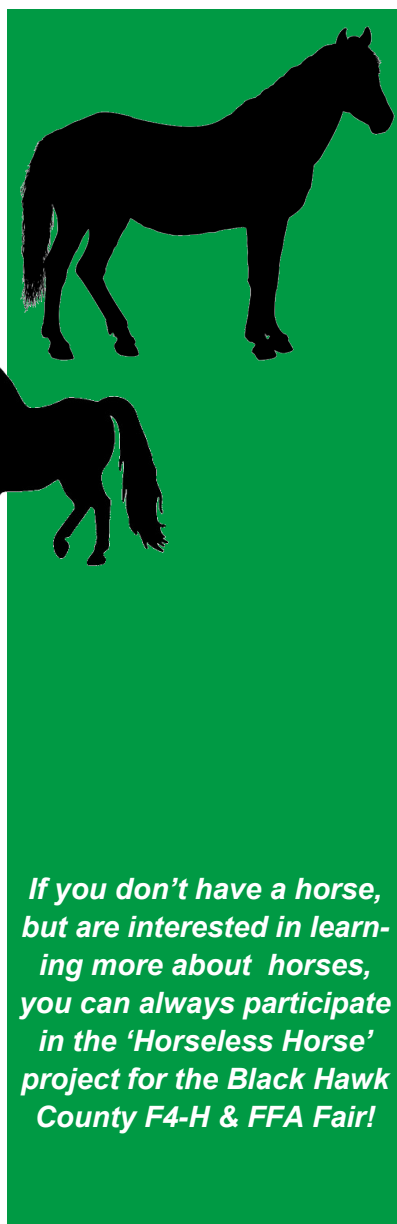


# HORSE & PONY CLUB

*The Horse & Pony Club works to: teach youth to appreciate riding as recreation, learn horsemanship skills and understand breeding, training, and raising horses as a business, and also acquire skills in horse management by owning and being responsible for an animal.*

*This club meets weekly for two months out of the year and requires a horse to participate. If you don't have a horse you may still be able to participate through using another individual's horse—contact our office and we can help!*

For almost all of our meetings youth will be practicing on their horse to gain skills. We have one no mounted meeting that generally takes place at the Black Hawk County 4-H & FFA Fair.
