Renewing Your Certification

Option 1:

One way to renew your certification (recertify) is to attend a private applicator Continuing Instruction Course (CIC) each of the three years during your renewal cycle.

****Check the mailing label for your certification number and expiration date.**

Example Mailing Label:

① 905712 ② 12/31/20 ③ 85
Stevens, Robert L.
412 Lakeside Dr.
Ames, IA 50010

① 905712 is the certification number

② 12/31/20 is the expiration date.

③ 85 refers to the county number.

December 31, 2020 Expiration:

Attendance at CIC programs in 2018–2019 and 2019–2020 and attending a CIC program between December 2020 and April 15, 2021 qualifies you for recertification.

December 31, 2021 Expiration:

Attendance at a CIC program in 2019–2020 and attending CIC programs in 2020–2021 and 2021–2022 qualifies you for recertification.

December 31, 2022 Expiration:

If you wish to recertify by training and not by exam, you must attend a CIC program each year, starting with the 2020–2021 program year.

Option 2:

A second way to recertify is to pass the certification test every three years. If you miss one year of CIC programs, Iowa law requires you to retest when your

certification expires. The exam is given by the Iowa Department of Agriculture and Land Stewardship (IDALS). You will need to call to schedule a time to test on the dates that they will be in Black Hawk County. They have testing times at 9am, 11am and 1pm social distancing will be in forced.

We offer testing the second Friday of every month. You **MUST** preregister at the IDALS website below.
