



# Boone County Livestock Committee Member Job Description

**PURPOSE:** Assist Livestock Superintendent with shows, exhibits, and educational activities in livestock divisions at Boone County Fair.

## COMMITTEE MEMBER RESPONSIBILITIES:

### Throughout the Year

- Attend committee meetings
- Become familiar with 4-H program, its purposes, and goals.
- Help organize educational opportunities as requested

### Pre-fair

- Assist with securing trophy donors
- Suggest fairbook division rule changes and provide input on suggested changes from others.
- Assist with **weigh-ins, testing or tattooing events** held in advance of fair, if applicable.
- Assist with pre- and post-fair **cleanup** for respective barns, if applicable.

### During County Fair

- Assist with fair **weigh-in/check-in**, if applicable.
- During show, perform one or more of the following duties:
  - a. Ring Announcer.
  - b. Check 4-H'ers into the ring (gatekeeper)
  - c. Ring helpers
  - d. Record ribbon placings (also be sure to note all no shows or changes)
  - e. Record champion placings for news releases
  - f. Other duties needed for a successful show

## QUALIFICATIONS OF COMMITTEE MEMBER:

- Ability to respectfully collaborate with others
- Experience working with respective species
- Ability to follow the directions of the Livestock Superintendent(s)
- Interest in youth and their development and in respective livestock area.
