Overall Condition
(grooming, skin condition, no parasites, clean)

Eyes & Nose
(should be clear, no eye or nasal discharge)

Ears
(clean, no mites, no "grease", no foul odor)

Nails
(clipped or declawed)

Teeth, Mouth
(no tartar, gingivitis, no bad breath)

Body Weight
(correct for size & age)

Temperament
(able to allow judge to examine, some grumbling allowed)

4-H Cat Project Record
(4-H'er should fill out the sections for health history, my cat's story, goals, action plan, and financial summary (and others that apply) on the 4-H Cat Project Record and bring it with them to the fair.)

Interview & Showmanship
(Ask 4-H'er about general knowledge about cats such as parts, common diseases, parasites, immunizations, etc. Have 4-H'er show how to check ears, nails, teeth, etc. Ask 4-H'er how to carry, pick up, pose, and hold the cat.)
