

**Boone County Community Endowment
2016
Grantmaking Fact Sheet**

- This is our 11th year of awarding grants.
- The Boone County Community Endowment received \$126,376, of which \$94,782 went into our Passthrough Fund for grantmaking and \$31,594 went into our permanent Endowment.
- In 2016, Grow Greene County funds became available to contiguous counties. \$18,200 in 2016.
- \$112,418 are being granted to non-profit community and charitable organizations in the county.
- 48 grant applications were received, totaling \$243,232 in requests.
- 27 grants were awarded to not-for profits agencies.
- Grant awards projects totaled \$1,041,880 in total project spending.
- Grant awards are broadly distributed into areas including education, community betterment, recreation and natural resources, cultural amenities, youth development and the arts.

HISTORY

- The process to establish this fund began on June 28, 2004 with a satellite broadcast in the Boone County ISU Extension Office with 20 Boone County residents present.
- The group met and began to form during meetings on September 9, 2004, October 25, 2004, November 29, 2004, and January 20, 2005. The charter Board members were selected, by-laws established and officer elections were held on Feb 21, 2005.
- The Boone County Endowment Fund Application was submitted on March 8, 2005 and approved in May, 2005. The Board next met to establish grant making procedures, the pass through fund and the petty cash fund on November 2, 2005.
- The February 15, 2006 minutes show a balance of \$16,152 in the Endowment Fund and \$43,270 in the pass through fund for granting. \$3,180 has been spent to establish the Fund and \$250 is in the petty cash account.
- The first awards ceremony was held on April 10, 2006 and \$42,883 was distributed. On April 12, 2007, \$47,974, in April of 2008 \$66,235, in April of 2009 \$98,269, \$105,650 in April of 2010, \$84,223 in 2011, \$84,095 in 2012, \$92,367 in 2013, \$104,065 in 2014 and \$89,800 in 2015. We are distributing a record \$112,418 in 2016.
- \$871,119 has been distributed through this granting process in Boone County including 2016.
