Eligibility Requirements and Rules for Leased Animals

- A “leased” animal is any animal not owned by the 4-H member or their immediate family (parents, siblings, guardians.) Animals owned by distant family (aunts, uncles, cousins, or grandparents are considered leased animals. A maximum of 6 animals per species may be leased per exhibitor.
- The objective of a leased projects is to allow 4-H members who do not own a large animal to learn the skills of feeding, management, care, and training of the animal. Through this experience they also learn the skills of decision-making, information gathering, communication, responsibility, and self-confidence.
- All animals, including leased animals, must be identified in 4hOnline by May 15.
- Exhibitors must meet all requirements included in 4H202 <https://store.extension.iastate.edu/product/194>
- Animals identified as part of a 4-H project cannot also be identified or exhibited as an FFA project or vice versa.
- The 4-H member agrees to provide a majority of the management, care, and training of the animal. This includes, but is not limited to, proper feeding, grooming, exercising, health and veterinary expenses, exhibitor fees, etc.
- The 4-H member agrees to make all reasonable efforts to keep the animal in a safe stall, pasture, corral, and to care for the animal as if they were the legal owner. The 4-H member has the right to exhibit the animal in all 4-H related activities.
- The 4-H member is expected to manage and care for the animal at least from May 15 through the end of the county fair.
- Fayette County 4-H reserves the right to disqualify leased animals of owners who have previously violated 4-H rules.
