

CLOVER KIDS – Animals

Entry fee: \$2.00 per entry, no premium, ribbon only, conference judged.

Enter animals in Fair Entry <https://bremer.fairentry.com> by **July 1st of the current year.**

1. Clover Kids are youth who have completed Kindergarten through 3rd grade. Clovers are learning about 4-H and its opportunities.
2. Clover Kids may bring small animals - Bottle/Bucket Calves, Bottle Lamb/Goat, Dog, Pet, Poultry and Rabbit. Animals must be entered in <https://bremer.fairentry.com> by **July 1st of the current year.**
 - a. Poultry must be checked in on Monday, July 29th from 5PM-6PM. Poultry **must** have proof of pullorum/typhoid testing at entry.
 - **Pullorum/typhoid testing:** Saturday, July 13th 5-7 pm Extension office in Tripoli.
Sunday, July 14th 5-7 pm Waverly Fairgrounds.
 - b. Rabbits must be checked in on Tuesday, July 30 from 6AM-8AM.
 - c. Dog and Pet are brought to fair the day of the show,
 - **Dog Show** – Wednesday, July 31st from 8AM-3PM. **Dogs are to be taken home after the show.*
 - **Pet Show** – Wednesday, July 31st at 3PM. **Pets are to be taken home after the show.*
 - d. Bottle/Bucket Lamb/Goats must be checked in on Thursday, August 1st from 4-5PM.
 - e. Bottle/Bucket calves' entry information is in the Bottle/Bucket Calf Fair Book page.
3. Clovers may exhibit **two** Livestock exhibits at the county fair.
4. Projects that might cause accidents or injury will not be accepted.
5. Exhibits must be checked out by superintendent or County Youth Coordinator.

Project requirements for Bottle Lamb/Goat Kid Class:

1. Judging will be Friday, August 2nd after meat goat and before the sheep show in the show arena.
2. \$2.00 entry fee, no premium, ribbon only, conference judged.
3. Project open to 4-H members in K-3.
4. Class is open to any newborn or orphan lamb/goat.
5. Lamb/goat must be born between January 1st and May 1st of the current year. The lamb/goat must be fed on a bottle/bucket before the lamb/goat is two weeks of age.
6. Members are responsible for the care. Care is to include feeding, training the lamb/goat to lead, and looking after the lamb's/goat's health.
7. Animal must be entered into Fair Entry <https://bremer.fairentry.com> by **July 1st of the current year.**
8. Lambs/goats will enter on Thursday at the Sheep/Goat check in and may leave after the show or during Livestock Release on Sunday.
9. Bottle lambs/goats do NOT need to be weighed May 6th but will be weighed at entry.
10. Arrangements for companion lambs must be made with the Extension by **July 1st.**
