Please remember that times are assigned to help prevent waiting in long lines. Check in at the Entry Table when you arrive. After you have your exhibits judged, go to the Exit Table to be checked out and receive your ribbon(s). Your exhibit will then be put in your booth for display unless it has been held back for Further Consideration. If there is a conflict with your club's assigned judging time, contact the Extension Office.

***To limit the number of people in the building we are going to ask that all booth set up/decorating happen BEFORE or AFTER judging (state selection is over).**
