Must be entered in <https://bremer.fairentry.com> on or before **July 15th** - entry fee \$2.00 per entry

No entry fee or premium for Showmanship Class

All youth participating in any and all mounted classes must wear an American Society of Testing Materials (ASTM) and Safety engineering Institute (SEI) approved headgear with chin strap and properly fitted harness AT ALL TIMES while mounted and riding, including warm up.

RULES and dress code.

1. All Horse & Pony Animal Identification must be filled out and on file (FFA) or entered in 4-H Online (4-H) in the Extension Office by **May 15, 2019**.
2. Animals will be inspected by an official veterinarian when unloaded on the grounds. Inspection of the animal prior to fair may be required.
3. **Mandatory Workouts** – Youth must participate in a least 3 of 8 workouts, offered by the Superintendent, to be eligible to show at the 2019 Bremer County Fair. **Workout Dates are:** April 16th, May 7th & 28th, June 11th & 20th, And July 9th & 23rd all starting a 5 PM.
4. **NEW*****All horses must have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection AND **Vaccinated for SST (Sleeping Sickness Tetanus) or Prestige 5 (or any combination thereof)
5. Exhibitors should wear dark pants or jeans, a solid plain, front button or snap long-sleeved, collared shirt of any color, and boots. The following is prohibited: personalized logos or embroidery, zippers, sheer or lace fabric, embellishments or bling of any kind (including sequins, rhinestones, chains, etc.). Shirts must be tucked in. Chaps, ball caps, tank tops, t-shirts, or jersey-type shirts ARE NOT to be worn. Western hats are required for all halter/showmanship classes.
6. Shirt must have the 4-H/FFA emblem. Horse armbands can be purchased and must be worn on the left arm.
7. Registered and unregistered animals will be shown together.
8. No stallions born before January 1, 2019 may be entered.
9. Ponies will be measured prior to the show.
10. Riders are required to dismount after all timed events before leaving the arena.
11. Prohibited medication, drug, mechanical, artificial appliance: No person shall administer internally or externally to a horse or pony, either before or during an approved event, any medication, drug, mechanical device, or artificial appliance, that is of such character as could affect the performance or appearance at the event.
12. "A Guide for Equine Shows in Iowa" Extension publication 4H-0511C, will be referenced and followed.
13. Patterns will be posted the day of the show.
14. Horse & Pony classes will be shown in numerical order unless the superintendent deems it necessary to change.
15. Exhibitors will only be allowed to run one horse for all timed events.
16. Horses shown in the Ranch Horse class may not be shown in the western pleasure class and vis versa. Horses and Ponies shown in the novice walk-trot may not be shown in the other pleasure classes and vis versa.

To be eligible for the Senior, Intermediate, & Junior High Point Awards, the exhibitor must enroll horse/rider combination by May 15th that will be counted toward High Point. Points will be earned based on the number of entries in each class. Example: If there are 10 entries in a class, 1st place earns 10 points, 2nd place earns 9 points, etc.

**Points from all eligible classes will be totaled per horse/rider combination. All classes will be considered for high point classes. Tie breakers: Most 1st, 2nd, 3rd place etc.; Highest Showmanship Placing.*
