2019 King Contest

Dear Contestant,

Thank you for your interest in the 2019 Buena Vista County Fair King Contest. The enclosed information will provide you with a general understanding of the qualifications and expectations of contestants, as well as specific details about the event.

Being selected as part of the Buena Vista County Fair Royalty should be considered a privilege and an honor. It is a serious commitment of time, not only the week of the fair, but throughout your year long reign at various special events and parades.

State and County Qualifications

- Each contestant must be at least 16 years of age and not more than 21 years of age on August 8-18, 2019 (First day of the Iowa State Fair.)
- The contestant must never have been married or have children.
- The County Fair King must reside in the county he represents.
- Contestants must be a resident of Iowa
- Each contestant must be an active member of at least one service organization in his community such as a Church group, Boy Scouts, 4-H, FFA, DECA, Habitat for Humanity, etc. (Eligibility is not limited to 4-H membership.)
- No professional model is eligible for the King Contest.
- King contestants should be available to represent the fair at all activities designated by the Buena Vista County Fair Queen/King Committee and the board must approve anything endorsed by the King.
- The Fair Queen/King Committee reserve the right to change the foregoing rules and regulations at any time deemed expedient.
- King contestants will be judged on personality, poise, attitude, and leadership in the community.

If the King fails to effectively represent the Buena Vista County Fair, he will be asked to return all prizes won and relinquish his title.

Expectations

- The King is expected to attend each day of the Buena Vista County Fair, July 5th-July 8th, 2019. The winner will hand out ribbons and trophies at various events at the fair.
- The King will also be introduced each night at the Grandstand events.
- Winners are also expected to represent the Buena Vista County Fair in parades and other various events throughout the year.
- If you are in 4-H and show at the fair, please let the Queen/King Committee know ahead what events so prior arrangements can be made to your schedule. These are not a guarantee.

These are the Parades Required. You can go to others if you wish:

- Star Spangled Spectacular Parade
- Cherokee Rodeo Parade
- Schaller Popcorn Days Parade

Other Expectations

- The King is expected to go around to local businesses and gather door prizes for the next year's winners and participants.
- The King will be asked back to help crown the new royalty at the 2020 Buena Vista County Fair.
- The King must be available to assist with the 2020 judging.

If for some reason the winner cannot fulfill his duties, the 1st runner-up will become the Buena Vista County Fair King.

Judging

Judging will take place at the AEA building in Storm Lake, 824 Flindt Dr, Storm Lake, IA. 50588. Week of June 24th, 2019 will be judging exact date and time to be determined. Sarah Brown will call you and let everyone know exact times and date for your interview. Contestants should wear nice dress clothes for interview. (Dress, Skirt, Dress Pants) No Denim.

Selection of the King

The judges that the Buena Vista County Fair Queen/King Committee chose will judge each King Contestant based on the application provided, short interview as well as personality, poise, and beauty. The judges will be looking for the neat, natural, creative, active in community, attractive, and mature adult.

Crowning

Crowning of the new KING will take place at the intermission of the Rodeo on Friday, July 5th, 2019. Please wear dress clothes. (Dress pants/ dress shorts) No jeans and no jogging pants. Each Contestant will be introduced before the crowning of the new Queen. The Buena Vista County Fair provides a crown and sash to the King winner ONLY. The Crown and Sash are NOT toys and should be handled with care. They should ONLY be worn during official events, competition & they are to be worn during the fair. If the crown/sash is broken, a replacement will NOT be provided.

Applications:

- **Each King contestant must complete and submit their application packet by June 14th @ 4:00 pm. (Must be postmarked by June 14th, 2019)**
- Application must be typed. If having problems with this please feel free to contact me.
- Each Queen contestant must submit a head and shoulder 4x6 or smaller photo (color or black & white). The photo must accompany application packet or you can email a jpg file. Photo does NOT have to be a professional photo. (These photos will be used in the paper so please choose your best one.)
