Important Fair Updates

- * **Fair Clean Up Day** is Sunday, July 12 at 1pm at the Fairgrounds. Only families showing livestock are encouraged to attend, and may bring their tack.
- * We are **NOT requiring CVI** papers for swine this year. We will have a vet inspect every animal prior to stepping on the fair grounds (except for dogs, as they have already provided their paperwork).
- * If you are bringing swine or market/breeding beef, you must leave your animal at the fairgrounds after they are weighed in and or checked in. Animals may not leave and then return to show off the trailer the day of the show.

Clover Crates.. Explore Outside the Box!

Important Static Information

Monday, July 13- Drop-Off:

- When exhibitors arrive, they will be handed a clip board with a static entry form and entry tags.
- Park and fill out the paperwork and place with exhibit on designated table outside of the legion.
- Properly attach all required paperwork to each exhibit.
- Staff will move the exhibit into the building where it will be judged on Tuesday, July 14.

Wednesday, July 15- Pick-Up:

- Each club's exhibits will be outside for pick-up during their scheduled time.
- We will have you initial paperwork when picking up exhibits to ensure they go home with the right member.
- Other families as well as leaders are allowed to drop off and or pick up other member's projects if needed.

Please contact the Extension office by Friday, July 10 if you do not plan to pick up your own exhibit on Wednesday, July 15.

Please let us know ASAP if you are unable to pick up or drop off exhibits during your scheduled time.

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Livestock Changes

Beef:

- No county raised or breed classes.
- Announcing Rate of Gain only
- Participants must sign up for showmanship by 5 p.m. on Saturday, July 18th to participate. There is a place on the pre-entry form to do this
- **CHANGE: There WILL be cow/calf pens, participants are not required to create a poster.**

Goats:

- No costume or Rate of Gain classes
- Participants must sign up by 5 p.m. on Wednesday, July 15th to participate. There is a place on the pre-entry form to do this.

Poultry:

- No changes

Rabbits:

- No costume class
- Participants must sign up for showmanship by 5 p.m. Friday, July 17th to participate. There is a place on the pre-entry form to do this.

Swine:

- Pen of 3 class will take place in the barns. No animals will leave the pens until the end of the class.
- Showmanship will take place during the entirety of the show and will not be a separate class.

Sheep:

- No Pen of 3 or Rate of Gain classes.
- Participants must sign up for showmanship by 5 p.m. on Wednesday, July 15th to participate. There is a place on the pre-entry form to do this.
- Weigh-ins will be assigned by club. Times are listed below:

Classes on all species may be reduced to ensure proper spacing in the show ring. Although the shows will continue, they will look different this year. Decisions made by the Fair Board, the Extension Office and superintendents will be final and will not be open to debate. We are working hard to put together an option for our members and hope that you will support us through these changes.

State Fair Livestock Entries

Iowa State Fair Entries will open soon in the Fair Entry program and will be due by July 10th. Again this year, families can pay online with a credit card or pay by check, with payment being sent directly to the Iowa State Fair. If you need help, please call the Extension Office. Make sure to do this early, as the Iowa State Fair does not allow late entries.
