YQCA Training Options

4-H and FFA Members, did you know you can complete YQCA training online anytime before July 1st?! An interactive in person training will take place Tuesday, March 25th from 6-8pm at the Cass County Community Building. Sign up for that training at <u>yqcaprogram.org</u>! Call the office if you have questions 712-243-1132. Go to <u>yqcaprogram.org</u> to log-in to your profile. Complete the pretest, training, and post-test then share a PDF copy of youth certificates to Katie at the Extension Office.

Youth can complete YQCA training anytime throughout the year online at their own pace by registering for a web-based training on YQCA. Over the weekend, a snow day, an evening or whenever works best for your schedule. The online training can be paused throughout out so you can start and stop as it works for your schedule. There is a pre and post-test to complete along with the training material. County Extension staff do not have access to families YQCA accounts.

Pioneer Seed Grants available to 4-H Clubs

Is your club planning a big community service project this year? There are grants out there to help cover costs! The objective of these grants is to stimulate local 4-H clubs in lowa to plan and carry out community improvement activities by providing "seed money" needed to make the projects successful. Pioneer will provide up to \$5,000 to selected 4-H clubs in lowa. Awards will be made directly to the clubs through the lowa 4-H Foundation from Pioneer as soon as selections are made. Grants will range from a minimum of \$50 to a maximum of \$500.

Clubs should submit their <u>applications</u> by January 15. A county staff member must review all applications submitted from the county's clubs, write appropriate comments where indicated, and approve the application. Pioneer Seed Grant completed applications and support letters will all be submitted through the JotForm application found at

https://www.extension.iastate.edu/4h/pioneergrants.

2024-2025 Program Year Enrollment

All youth K-12 must re-enroll in 4-HOnline <u>each year</u> to keep active 4-H or Clover Kid member status. Do this early in the year to stay in the loop for upcoming events! Select project areas you may be interested in to get broadcast emails from the state/county regarding opportunities to further your learning and add to your record book in that project area! We would like to have all returning members re-enrolled early to participate in activities. Please be sure and check your **correspondence preference for 4-H Newsletters**. You will need to select mail or email.

Go to <u>https://v2.4honline.com/#/user/sign-in</u> and log in with your email and password. A quick link is also available on the Extension webpage. It is okay to select "reset password" option and the program will walk you through the steps of getting a new password. Beef Identification

All Exhibitors need to identify their beef online before Saturday, February 1st at 11:59pm to be eligible to exhibit at County or State Fair. Katie will not be available after 4:30pm Friday, January 31st. Plan ahead of the deadline if you have questions or need help with the process. Refer to the handouts provided at weigh-in for step-by-step instructions. 4-H animals are identified in 4-HOnline and FFA animals are identified in FairEntry.

If there is a chance you will exhibit as a breeding animal, add in the birthdate to the animal. Identifying it as market animal <u>with a birthdate</u> it will be eligible for market or breeding classes at county fair.

<u>Breeding Heifers:</u> All breeding heifers are required to have two forms of identification. They <u>must</u> have a tattoo and a 4-H/FFA ear tag or registration number.

2025 Fairbook Rules

The 2025 Fairbook is being updated by superintendents and fairboard in the "off season". Departments are being posted on Cass County Extension's website under the 4-H and Youth drop down find the county fair section, <u>www.extension.iastate.edu/cass/county-fair</u>. Changes are listed in RED for each department on the left hand side of the webpage.

Get ahead on your 2024-2025 Record Book!

Forms are on our website, <u>www.extension.iastate.edu/cass/record-keeping</u> Now is the time to set goals for your 4-H projects to work toward them during the year. Remember to set goals that are attainable, have a time frame on them and you will be able to track the results. You cannot control the ribbon a judge will give you on a certain day, but you can work toward an average daily gain, or the animal's ability to walk with you.

As you participate in activities at home, in the community, at school, and in your club be sure to write them down so you don't forget next September.
