What is 4-H?

The 4-H promise to youth and parents is: fun, friends, voice, choices, great trips, and events, a safe place to learn and try new things, leadership, citizenship, communication skills, service opportunities, adults who care, and hands-on learning experiences.

4-H allows youth to explore whatever interests them, with over 45 project areas ranging from aerospace to woodworking, pets to horses, photography to science and technology.

4-H is for school-aged youth. Clover Kids is for youth currently enrolled in grades K-3. Community 4-H clubs are for youth currently enrolled in grades 4-12.

What can 4-H members do?

- Attend club and project meetings, serve as club officers
- Give back to others in their club and community
- Learn recordkeeping skills
- Participate in county wide activities
- Exhibit at county fair, attend camps, make friends, & travel

- Choose a 4-H club to join. Contact the leader to find out when you can visit a meeting.
- Select one or more 4-H project areas you want to learn about.
- Complete the enrollment information on 4-HOnline. Enrollment instructions can be found on the Cass County Extension website, or from a club leader.
