- Project Award applications must be submitted, with record books, to your club leader by their deadline. All senior level award applications are due, from Leaders, to the Cass County Extension Office by **October 2**.
- Intermediate level 4-H members must receive a minimum of 21 points. Junior level 4-H members must receive a minimum of 18 points to win a Project Award. Awards given at club level will be automatically received by members- there is no county contest.
