Schedule of Events

July 2: Deadline for returning the questionnaire. **NO late forms accepted!**

July 13: Individual interview with judges at the **Community Center** in Atlantic. You will have five to ten minutes individually to visit with the judges. Be prepared to discuss yourself, family and leadership activities. Wear a knee-length dress or dressy pants. Individual Queen Candidate pictures will be taken at the Community Center at approximately 9:50 A.M. A group picture with the Queen and King candidates will be taken at approximately 11:45 A.M. Judges will join everyone for a lunch at 12:00 noon. Queen interviews will resume after lunch (an exact schedule will be sent later).

July 23: Meet at the Extension Office at **6:30 P.M.** with your escort. You will enter the stage, give your name, parent's name, and 4-H Club/FFA Chapter, and then be seated on stage. After the final announcement of the Queen and runner-up, picture taking and radio interviews, you are free to leave. Thank you in advance for your participation.
