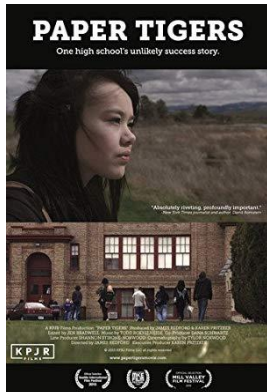


## Documentaries Available for Check-Out
