

Frequently Asked Questions about Curriculum and Kits

Q. How long can we borrow the curriculum and kits?

A. Two Weeks

Q. Do we teach the lessons or do you have staff that teach them?

A. Typically, teachers borrow and present their own lessons. In some situations we may have a staff member available to present lessons for a fee. Call the Cedar County Extension office at 563-886-6157.

Q. Do the kits come with all the supplies needed to deliver the lessons?

A. Usually, yes. However, some curriculum and kits require perishable items (like milk or fruit) that may need to be purchased by the user.

Q. Do I have to replenish the items in the kit before I bring them back?

A. No. Cedar County Extension incurs the cost of replenishing the kits. The user is responsible for the replacement costs of nonconsumable items (such as science equipment) that are broken or lost during use at the value of the item. Users by checking out the kit will agree to the terms.
