Scholarships

Iowa 4-H Foundation Scholarship information is available at: https://www.iowa4hfoundation.org/en/funding_for_4hers/scholarships/ Applicants must enroll as a full-time student (minimum of 12 credit hours) to receive scholarship awards. Only ONE application form is needed for all Iowa 4-H scholarships. Eligible Iowa 4-H youth may apply for more than one scholarship, however, only one scholarship per individual will be awarded per academic year.

To be eligible for any of the Iowa 4-H Foundation Scholarships **2 letters of recommendation** are required - one from an Extension staff member or 4-H volunteer and one from a school/college academic advisor or teacher. College undergraduates may submit both letters from academic advisors.

Market Beef Weigh-In
