- Provide daily feed and fresh water
- Bedding is changed regularly
- Rabbit has an annual veterinarian health check (additional visits if medically necessary)
 - Purchase and administer any medicine that might be required for treatment
- Provide proper grooming for your rabbit breed as needed (clean/bathe, brush, nail trim, etc.)
- Provide supervision of uncaged rabbit. Do not allow rabbit loose in yard/home, the rabbit can be injured if not being supervised by exhibitor or family members.
- Provide adequate housing/cage for rabbit size and environmental conditions
- Provide loving care towards the rabbit – treat kindly
- Complete YQCA training (if 4th grade or older by 2024 fair)
- I agree to show this rabbit at the 2024 Chickasaw Co. 4-H & FFA Achievement Show (fair)
