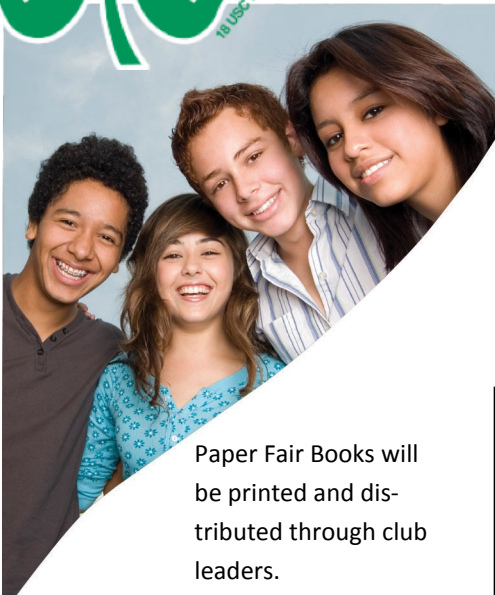

Edit: Choose member from Member List, click "Edit"

Animals/Livestock: Locate at top left (below green 4H) and Click Animals/Livestock

Select Animal Type: Choose animal you want to enter from drop down list. Click the "Add" button below drop-down box. **Reactivate your dogs, horses and dairy.**

Enter Animal Information: Read the information at the top of each screen, particularly if you are considering exhibiting at the state fair. Some fields that are NOT required (bold) are actually necessary for state fair animals. For each animal entered, enter all the information requested and click the save button. **All fields in bold are required.
